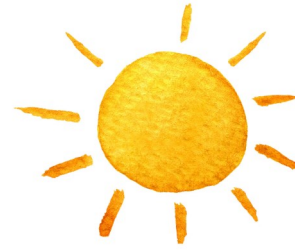

Mr Spring, who has been with us for just under 16 years is also leaving us to take up a position in another school.

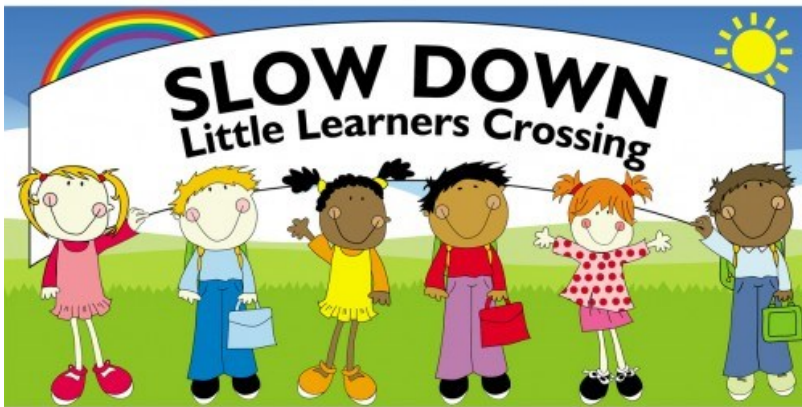
I know you will join with me in thanking them for all their hard work and commitment that they have given to the school and wishing them all the best for the future. I know that everyone here is really going to miss them.
