THE BOOK FAIR IS COMING TO LITTLE HEATH


Next week we have the Book Fair in school.

KEY STAGE ONE MORNING DROP OFF



From Monday, 24th September we would like children in Years 1 and 2 to be dropped off at their classroom door.

The infant gates will be opened at 8.40am and they will be closed at 8.50am.

If you arrive to school after this time, your child will need to enter school through the school office.

Children in Years 3, 4, 5 and 6 will still enter school through the main entrance.

Focus on School Gateway

We have a fully operating cashless system called 'Schoolcomms' where you can give consent, make payments for school trips and top up our child's dinner money account. However, we still only have 78% of parents signed up on the Gateway and only 52% using the App.



'Schoolcomms' is the most effective way for you to keep track of your children's payments and consents. We will be phasing out paper copies of letters and consents over the coming weeks.

If you have a smartphone, please download 'School Gateway' from your app store. Alternatively, you can visit the website www.schoolgateway.com and click on 'New User'. You will receive a text message with a PIN number. Use this PIN to log in to School Gateway.

We will notify you by text or email when new items are available for payment.

If you can't access your account, it may be because we do not have your most up to date email and telephone number on record.

Please pop in if you are unsure about what to do.

We hope that you will find School Gateway to be a fast and easy way to pay for your school items and give consent for clubs and visits.
